GREENLAND® was retained by the County of Simcoe to provide civil engineering and landscape architectural services for a Paramedic Station in the Town of Collingwood, Ontario.

GREENLAND® was also responsible for preparation of a tree inventory and tree preservation plan, detailed landscape design, working drawings and specifications, opinion of probable cost and construction administration tasks including final certification of the landscape works.

The landscape design was undertaken to meet the urban design manual and design standards of the Town of Collingwood and the needs of the County of Simcoe.

Existing trees were retained where possible so the paramedic station fit into the existing residential neighbourhood adjacent to the heritage district.



Landscape design elements include flag poles, seating areas and bicycle parking for staff, native trees, shrubs, ornamental grasses and perennials.

Detailed designs (site servicing and landscape architecture) were approved and completed in July of 2017. The award-winning facility was constructed at the end October 2018. Also, since the project completion, GREENLAND® was retained in 2019 and 2020 by the client for other similar Emergency Management Operations (EMO) facilities too.
