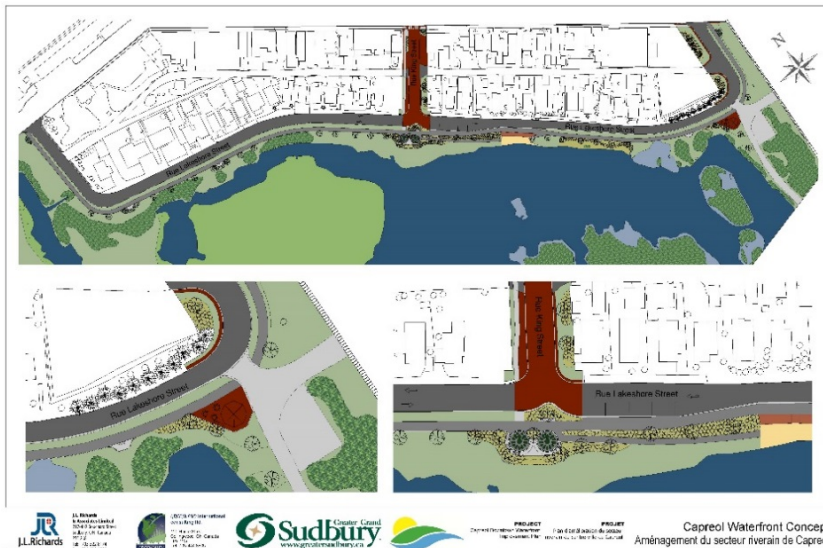

Capreol Downtown Waterfront Improvement Plan

GREENLAND® was retained by J.L. Richards & Associates Limited to provide landscape architectural services for the Capreol Downtown Waterfront Improvement Plan in the Town of Capreol, City of Greater Sudbury, Ontario. GREENLAND® was responsible for preparation of the landscape concept completed in July 2014 and preparation of construction drawings and specifications for the landscape works was then initiated in the spring of 2016.



The landscape design was undertaken to connect activities and improve the appearance and functional capacity of passive and active recreational opportunities on Lakeshore and King Street without adversely affecting the properties of the existing flood control berm.

An accessible and visible transition between the Capreol Waterfront along Lakeshore Street and downtown Capreol via King Street was created by providing clear and accessible

streetscaping, pathways, trails and unified landscape design elements and furnishings with an historical railway theme.

Based on feedback from the municipality, regulatory agencies and the public engagement process, opportunities to introduce public art, historical interpretation, shaded seating areas, pedestrian and cycling paths, activity and trail linkages and other program opportunities were identified and incorporated into the design.

The detailed design phase of the project was completed in the winter of 2016 and construction was completed in the summer of 2018.
